Seaway Crude Oil Pipeline Strike

January 30, 2017 – At approximately 3:30 p.m. CST today, Seaway Crude Pipeline Company LLC experienced a release from its 30-inch diameter S-1 line after being struck by a third party contractor. The incident, which occurred near Trenton, Texas in Collin County, resulted in no fire or injuries and the pipeline has been shut down and isolated.

Seaway has mobilized personnel and equipment to the site and is working closely with emergency responders, law enforcement and regulatory authorities to conduct clean-up operations and develop a plan to resume operations as quickly and safely as possible. Two small businesses within a quarter-mile of the incident were evacuated as a safety precaution

Seaway Crude Pipeline Company LLC is 50/50 joint venture owned by affiliates of Enterprise Products Partners L.P. and Enbridge Inc. In addition to the pipeline that transports crude oil from Cushing to the Gulf Coast, the Seaway system is comprised of a terminal and distribution network originating in Texas City, Texas, which serves refineries locally and in the Houston area.
